



North Central Newfoundland Club Membership Information

The North Central Newfoundland Club (NCNC) is a non-profit regional organization recognized by the AKC sanctioned Newfoundland Club of America (NCA) to preserve and protect the Newfoundland dog in Chicago, northern Illinois, Wisconsin and eastern Iowa. Club members meet quarterly to plan and carry out the activities of the club which include water training classes, a picnic/fun match, a holiday party, an Education Day, a Regional Specialty, a Draft Test, a Water Test, a bimonthly newsletter, and other functions to bring out the unique qualities of the Newfoundland dog and enhance our enjoyment of our Newf.

Rescue Service

Pre-screened homes are found for adult and puppy Newfs who, for various reasons, are unsuited to their present homes.

Water Training Classes

Water rescue skills are taught by experienced instructors to properly enhance the life-saving instincts of the Newf. Classes prepare owners and dogs to qualify as WD (Water Dog), WRD (Water Rescue Dog) or WRDX (Water Rescue Dog Excellent).

Draft & Water Tests

We annually host a Draft Test to allow trained Newfs to demonstrate their draft work ability, and a Water Test to demonstrate their natural abilities in an aquatic environment.

Regional Specialty

The Club, with permission of the NCA hosts a Regional Conformation and Obedience Show.

Annual Fun Day

Activities include a Fun Match, games, working demonstrations, and an auction.

Education Day

A day for learning more about Newfs, short presentations, videos, demonstrations, and hands-on help for Newfs, their owners and those who want to know more about the breed and the Club.

Newf News

Our bimonthly newsletter providing educational and other information and reports on the activities of the Club and its members.

Supported Entries

The Club provides trophies to recognize Newfs in conformation and obedience at three or four shows during the year. Club meetings are often held at these show sites.

Annual Awards Banquet

In the Spring, the club meets to honor those owners and their Newfs who have earned titles during the preceding year.
